

Academician Hanjalic BURCH Honorary Ph.D. Holder Among the Top 10 Scientists in The World

The Global Energy Prize is an international award which annually honors outstanding achievements in energy research and technology from around the world that are helping address the world's various and pressing energy challenges.

Among 44 scientists from 14 countries who have contended for the Prize in its XVI cycle, International Burch University honorary Ph.D. member, Professor Kemal Hanjalic was shortlisted among top 10 candidates - "For outstanding contribution into the development of the fundamentals of thermal physics, experimental and computational methods of studying turbulence and eddy flows of multiphase media with the aim of developing modern power-generating and energy-saving equipment."

At the official press conference held on June 6, 2018, at the TASS press center in Moscow, the award committee chaired by Nobel Prize winner Rodney John Allam awarded this year's award to Sergey Alenescu (Russia) and Martino Green (Australia).
